

# PRESENTATION AND OBJECTIVES

Since the dawn of time, human beings have used plants for food, treatment of illnesses and to adorn themselves. The plants are certainly the first medicines used by men. The abstract must not exceed 300 words and must specify the objectives, methods and results of the study. The title of the abstract must be written in Times New Roman, centered, font 12, bold and lowercase. The names of authors, co-authors, affiliations as well as email address of corresponding author, must be presented just after the title, centered, single-spaced, font 10. Abstracts must also contain a maximum of 5 keywords.

The abstracts as well as the registration form must be sent to the e-mail address corresponding to each theme. Abstracts must be written in English and sent in a **Word version** (docx).
