Microbial Ecology is the study of interrelationships between microorganisms and their living and nonliving environments. It includes the study of symbioses, biogeochemical cycles and the interaction of microbes with anthropogenic effects such as pollution and climate change. Microbial ecology is currently undergoing a revolution, with repercussions spreading throughout microbiology, ecology and ecosystem science. Understanding the ecology of microorganisms is one of the most undeniable intellectual challenges since it is essential to meet many of the major challenges facing human society today in environmental, agricultural, food, and industrial areas. Moreover, the rapid accumulation of molecular data is showing vast diversity, abundant uncultivated microbial groups and novel microbial functions which allow the study of activities of complex communities of microbes in natural, managed and engineered ecosystems.

This first conference on "*Microbial Ecology: Towards New Challenges*" has now become a need for us. The meeting will be organized by the Laboratory of Applied Microbiology from the University of Sétif1, Algeria, in collaboration with the Tunisian Society for Microbial Ecology (ATEM) and the Laboratory of Microorganisms and Actives Biomolecules (LMBA) from the University of Tunis El Manar. It will enable researchers working in the different fields of microbial ecology to meet and to exchange their scientific competences and their exciting findings. It will also offer the opportunity for young researchers to learn from experts and form new collaborations so deepen their knowledge while broadening their horizons. During this conference, important and topical themes, where microbial ecology plays a key role, will be addressed: *i) Microbial Biodiversity ii) Health and Environment iii) Adaptations / Biotic Interactions and iv) Microbial Biotechnology and Agro-Industry.*

City of Sétif

The city of Sétif is located north-east of Algeria, 300 km east of the capital city Algiers at 1100 m of altitude in the high plains. The climate is continental with hot, dry summers and harsh winters. The province is the second in population after Algiers. The city has an international airport located at 12 km west of the city.

Sétif is a city whose name derives from a Berber word that means black soil related to its fertility and was called by the Romans Sitifis. The city has a rich archaeological heritage; it was listed as World Heritage in 1981. It preserves vestiges of the third and fourth century exposed in the Archaeological Museum of the city that traces its history: prehistory, Numidia, Rome, and the advent of Islam. The tomb of "Scipion the African" is also in the region. Various steles are located in the garden Amir Abd El-Kader (ex garden of Orleans) in relation to the site of Cuicul called today Diemila, Roman town located 30 Km of Sétif, built in 98, then enlarges in the 3rd century during the reign of the Caracalla Emperor. Setif also is famous for its "Ain El Fouara" fountain located in the city center and a monument on which rests a statue of a woman. This impressive artistic representation was realized by Saint Vidal in 1898.
