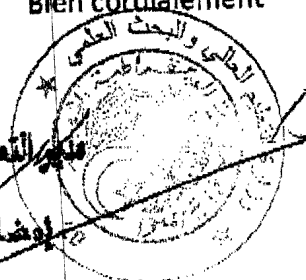

**Subject: Nominations for the ICGEB Council of Scientific Advisers**

Madam,

I have the honour to refer to the decisions taken on the above Subject by the Board of Governors of the International Centre for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology (ICGEB) during its eighteenth session, held in Trieste, Italy on 16-18 November 2011, and subsequently during the Board's First Special Session, held in Trieste on 6-7 June 2012.

In particular, I wish to refer to the issue relevant to the expiry of the term of service of five members of the Council of Scientific Advisers (CSA), which was fixed on 31 December 2012. As you may be aware, during its first special session, the Board decided to postpone the nineteenth regular session of the Board to the first quarter of 2013, and to postpone the mandate of the current CSA members to 30 June 2013, accordingly (Document ICGEB/BG-SS.1/11 Conclusions and Decisions, paragraphs 41- 43).

I am therefore pleased to draw your attention to the procedure for the nomination of candidates to the five positions of the CSA to be filled during the nineteenth session of the Board of Governors, which will be held in Trieste, Italy, on 14-15 May 2013.

The approved procedure calls for Members of the Board to nominate candidates for the Council (one nomination per Member State). These nominations should be communicated to the President of the Board no later than 31 December 2012, and should be accompanied by all information relevant to the scientific or technical qualifications of the candidates, as well as by any complementary background information on the candidate relevant to the work of the Centre. The President will circulate the nominations to all Members of the Board, while the ICGEB Director-General will ascertain the availability of the candidates to serve on the Council, if elected. At the nineteenth session of the Board, the President will set up a selection committee, composed of no more than one scientific expert from each Delegation (the Director-General will participate in the selection committee, without voting rights), which shall examine the credentials of the candidates and submit to the Board a list of names corresponding to the five positions to be filled. The Board will make every effort to elect the five members of the Council by consensus.

Please note that three members of the Council, whose term of service expires on 30 June 2013, i.e. Professors Ananda Chakrabarty (U.S.A.), Rafael Radi (Uruguay) and Marc Van Montagu (Belgium), are eligible for a further term, should they so wish, and should they be nominated by a Member State. Professors Muntaser Ibrahim (Sudan) and Radovan Komel (Slovenia), having completed their third consecutive term, are not immediately re-eligible for a further term.

Each nomination should be accompanied by a curriculum vitae of the candidate, together with a one-page summary of his/her scientific and technical qualifications; only this page will be circulated to all Members of the Board, together with the list of nominees, while the details of the curriculum vitae of all the candidates will be distributed on request, and shall be made available on the ICGEB web site page containing the Board's session documents.

Should your Government decide to nominate a candidate, I would appreciate if such nomination could be sent, within the indicated deadline, to the President of the Board of Governors, Prof. H. Moursy c/o the Secretary of the Board, Mr. D. Ripandelli, Padriciano 99, 34149 Trieste, Italy.
