## **PROMISES AND CHALLENGES OF THE ALGERIAN UNIVERSITY AFTER THE FIVE-YEAR LMD REFORM**

**April 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

### **Statement of the problem**

The LMD architecture has been introduced in Algeria in the year 2004-2005. Many questions have hitherto aroused according to its implementation and relevance. In this context of globalization, however, such an implementation seemed to represent the best choice in order to follow the pace of the twenty-first century internationalization. However, a successful introduction of the LMD system is yet dependent on the integration of the aspects of the Algerian university. In this context, although the equivalence of diplomas is to a higher extent "guaranteed", it is necessary not only to locate the LMD project in the economic and social development, but to make it relevant to the Algerian context of adaptability. Consideration should also be given to potential jobs for graduates in order to lessen the pressure of the Master's rush from all university students.

Furthermore, our apprehension facing the LMD system is justified by the fact that it is easier to change laws than attitudes, and reform is only achieved by persons who are to implement it.

### **Objectives of the Conference**

The mission of this conference is to advance knowledge about Higher Education and the LMD reform after five years from its implementation. Thus, its objectives may go around the following:

- ✓ To redefine the university as an agent of social transformation committed to a democratically negotiated definition of the public good.
- ✓ To strengthen the role that the Algerian universities play in promoting educational access and social mobility.
- ✓ To challenge the role the Algerian university plays in advancing science and technology.
- ✓ To enhance the development of Higher Education in Algeria in a manner most beneficial to the development of the country by introducing ICT.
- ✓ To establish Quality Assurance as a key notion in ensuring the quality of the educational product.

### **Expected outcomes**

The present conference holds some expected outcomes that may be summarized in the following:

- ✓ Develop a solid base for a correct implementation of the LMD system in our departments and universities alike.
- ✓ Create a dynamic atmosphere within teachers and researchers of the English department.
- ✓ Move a step forward after the five year experience and ask more relevant questions that touch upon the Algerian case.
- ✓ Develop case studies about “what is missing” for a successful implementation in the Algerian context.
- ✓ Make a selection of proceedings for publication in a special issue pertaining to the conference.
- ✓ Open the gates wide-open for further scientific discussions on educational issues.
